

Pickup Switch Upgrade™ Selection Chart

Updated: 07/07/2013

This chart will help you select the correct **Pickup Switch Upgrade™** product based on both the number and type of pickups in your instrument, which will be either “S” (single-coil) pickups or “H” (humbucker) pickups.

In all instances, a 2-wire humbucker pickup can serve as an “S” (single-coil) pickup.

S	None	No Pickup Switch Upgrade™ product can be used.
H	T2-Switch product.	Must be a 4-wire humbucker pickup. Gives you 6 pickup tones.
SS	T2-Switch product	Gives you 6 pickup tones.
HS, SH	T2-Switch product	You must have a 2-wire humbucker pickup. ¹
HH	T2-Switch product	You must have two 2-wire humbucker pickups. ¹
HS, SH	T3-Switch product	You must have a 4-wire humbucker pickup.
SSS, HS, SH	T3-Switch product	You must have a 4-wire humbucker pickup.
HH	T3-Switch product	You must have one 4-wire humbucker pickup and one 2-wire humbucker pickup.
HSS, SHS, SSH	T3-Switch product	You must have one 2-wire humbucker pickup. ¹
HSH, SHH, HHS	T3-Switch product	You must have two 2-wire humbucker pickups. ¹
HHH	T3-Switch product	You must have three 2-wire humbucker pickups. ¹
SSSS	T4-Switch product	You must have four single-coil pickups.
HH	T4-Switch product	You must have two 4-wire humbucker pickups.
HSS, SHS, SSH	T4-Switch product	You must have one 4-wire humbucker pickup.
HSH, SHH, HHS	T4-Switch product	You must have one 4-wire humbucker pickup and one 2-wire humbucker pickup.
HHH	T4-Switch product	You must have one 4-wire humbucker pickup and two 2-wire humbucker pickups. ¹
